
Listen, while you're back at Head Quarters getting that truth cannon, can you bring me a couple of doughnuts please?

'Silas?' interrupted Erika. 'Is that you? Why are you invisible? And *please* stop humming.'


The humming stopped. 'Oh. Am I still invisible?'







Remember – it's a dream, so anything can happen!




