We understand that calculating the perfect quantity can be a challenge. To help you order the right amount, our system features **optional, flexible bundles** that illustrate the value and convenience we offer as your trusted breakfast club partner. After entering the number of children you expect to feed, you can select and customize your order. All bundles are a guide only, and you remain free to adjust the number of individual products at any time.

This is a tool you can choose to use to support ordering, not essential. If you know exactly what products and quantities you require, you can just order those items specifically.

Once a bundle has been selected, you can add or remove products to enhance your breakfast offer to cater for the specific needs of your pupils.

Examples of optional Bundle Selections:
